The online platform is hosted by the International Policy Centre for Inclusive Growth (IPC-IG), and facilitated by the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade (DFAT) of Australia, and the *Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) GmbH*, on behalf of the German Federal Ministry of Economic Development and Cooperation (BMZ).
