The **e-Learning Hub** allows users to access e-courses on social protection. Members and users can browse upcoming and past e-learning opportunities offered by our partners or hosted on **socialprotection.org**.

Courses are divided into three categories:

01

**Self-paced e-courses:** designed to be followed at the student's own speed, with independent tasks and assignments.

02

**Instructor-led e-courses:** synchronous and asynchronous e-courses guided by a tutor or instructor, following a specified schedule.

03

**Virtual Campus:** free e-courses organised and produced by socialprotection.org in partnership with key stakeholders.

Members of **socialprotection.org** can **Share** e-courses to the platform to appear in the **e-Learning Hub**. To do this, click on the **Share** tab and select **Online Courses**.

Our partners can also collaborate with our team in the development of self-paced and instructor-led e-courses using our **Virtual Campus**, a Moodle-based learning management system.
