

## The Virtual Campus includes three conent types:

- Self-paced e-courses: online courses designed to be followed at the student's own speed, with independent tasks and assignments.
- **Instructor-led e-courses:** synchronous and asynchronous online courses guided by a tutor or instructor, with a specified schedule.
- **Webinars:** live online seminars featuring presentations from social protection experts from around the world.
